Christmas Ball

What do I need?

Parchment paper flex (PG61450)

Multi grid 10 (PG31450)

Embossing tools: large ball (PG10021), small ball (PG10011), extra small ball stainless steel (PG10072)

Perforating tool: 1-needle (PG10241)

Pointed scissors ring-lock (PG11315) or perforating tool 2-split (PG10225)

Embossing mat A4+ (PG31416)

Perforating mat A4+ (PG31417)

Light green cardstock

Scrap paper K&Company Swell Noël green holiday stripes (651388)

Olive green cardstock

Gold coloured brad

Gold coloured ribbon (0.3cm wide, 6cm long)

1 flower sticker K&Company Swell Noël (569249)

Craft box basics

How do I make it?

Cut and fold light green cardstock to create a 11x15cm card blank. Cut a 10.5x14.5cm piece of scrap paper and fix to the centre of the card front.

Attach parchment paper with masking tape on the multi grid and place this all on the embossing mat. Emboss the Christmas ball with the embossing tools. Turn the multi grid over, with the parchment paper still attached, and place it on the perforating mat. Perforate the Christmas ball according to the example.

Attach olive green paper with masking tape under the multi grid and place it on the perforating mat. Perforate the outline of the Christmas ball. Cut the Christmas balls out along the perforations or perforate the outer perforations a second time with perforating tool 2-split and carefully press them out.

Cut a 4x14cm strip of olive green cardstock. Attach the flower sticker to the strip. Fix the ribbon with double sided tape and attach the Christmas balls with a brad. Attach the strip with foam pads to the card. **Card is made by Anja Bakker**
