



Quickutz Revolution Good Luck Flower Card

Products used:

Quickutz Revolution Tool

Quickutz Flower Die (QKREV-0017)

Quickutz Shortkutz Die (QKSK-0001)

6" x 6" green scored card

5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " pale green cardstock

4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " raspberry cardstock

K & Co Lavender Stripes flat paper (644014)

2 x 6" lengths of dotty ribbon

4 green brads

Corner rounder punch

2 pieces of pink and raspberry cardstock for die cutting flower and phrase.



Firstly cut your cardstock to the sizes above and using your corner punch, round off the corners.

Then using the Revolution cut out your flower in raspberry, then again in pink. Interchange the petals so you have a colour co-ordinated flower. Die cut your "Good Luck" phrase from pink cardstock.

Evenly place your dotty ribbon 3" across your pale green cardstock vertical and horizontal to form a cross shape. Insert your brads $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the sides.

Mat and layer your lavender stripes paper onto the raspberry cardstock, then again onto the pale green cardstock. Finally adhere onto your green scored card.

Now adhere your flower image onto the centre of the lavender stripes and adhere your Good Luck phrase along the bottom.

This is a lovely, easy card to make and it's also very effective. You can also change the phrase to suit your occasion.
