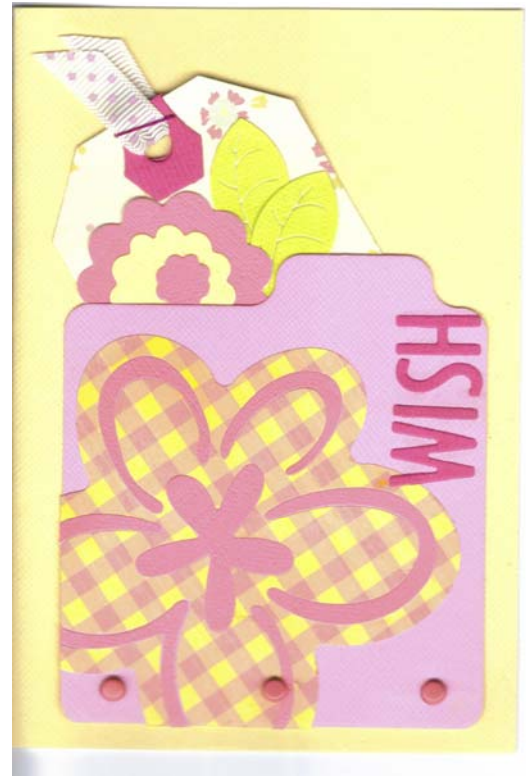
Pink and raspberry cardstock

Small piece of ribbon for tag

3 Pink brads

Stapler (optional)

C6 pale lemon card



Die cut the mini album using pink cardstock, the large flower using the peach gingham paper and again die cut the large flower using the pink card from the Tropical Quickstripz pad. Adhere the gingham flower onto the mini album, overlapping to the left side (fold the petal under the side of the album). Place your deep pink petal inserts into the flower head. Insert your 3 pink brads into the pre-cut holes of the mini album. Now die cut the words "WISH" from raspberry cardstock and adhere to the right hand side.

Die cut your tag using the K & Co prairie flower paper and again die cut the tag topper in raspberry cardstock, secure to tag. Insert your ribbon through the tag topper and you can either staple it as I have done, or tie it in place.

Using the Tropical Quickstripz die cut a few flower heads in various shades of pinks and yellow and a couple of green leaves. Stick these to the top end of your tag.

Take double sided tape and put this around the bottom, left and right hand side of the back of your mini album, secure onto your C6 card.

The Tag can either sit freely inside this 'pocket' or you can glue in place.
