



“Rudolph” Card – By Kate Ganson

Materials used

21 x 15cm green card:

Striped Christmas paper:

Red, green & white card: (stock code: AC71030, AC71056, PIWCARD)

Rudolph Stamp: (stock code: PICS030 clear stamp set)

Elf Stamp: (PICS030 clear stamp set)

Happy Christmas Stamp: (PICS030 clear stamp set)

Black Ink Pad: (VSF82)

Marvy Brush Marker Pens

Glossy Accents (stock code: GAC17042)

Green ribbon: (DE118)

Double sided tape: (stock code: 3.3183)

3D foam Pads: (stock code: 3.3100)

Instructions

1. Fold green card in half to make base card. Mat and layer green, red and white card as shown. Cover front of base card with striped paper leaving a small border.
2. Stamp Elf and Rudolph image in black ink, and colour the design. Mat onto layers made from green, red and white layers & stick to upper centre of front of base.
3. Stick piece of green ribbon to bottom of card, tie a small knot onto the ribbon prior to sticking down with double sided tape.
4. Stamp and colour ‘Happy Christmas’ sentiment and secure in place using 3D foam pads.
5. When all the pieces are in place, apply Glossy Accents to Rudolph’s ‘nose’, ‘sign’ and ‘greeting’. Leave to dry.
