

CARD INSTRUCTIONS FOR SPRING WITH PERGAMANO

GENERAL

The card is made of bright and cheerful spring scrapbook paper (30X15 cm). A front sheet of ordinary parchment paper (15x2,8 cm) is attached to the card. Two butterflies of any coloured parchment paper are also attached to the card.

EMBOSSING ON GRID

Attach a sheet of coloured parchment paper on multi grid no 8. Please note, when you use coloured parchment paper with a shiny and a mat side you need to hold the shiny side up to emboss. Emboss the butterfly with embossing tools extra small ball stainless steel (PG10072) and small ball (PG10011) according to the example.

PERFORATING ON GRID

Turn the grid around, together with the parchment paper, so that the parchment paper is underneath the grid. Perforate the outer line of the butterfly with perforating tool 1-needle (PG10241). See example. Remove the parchment paper from the grid and repeat these two steps with another colour parchment paper.

EMBOSSING ON GRID

Take the piece of ordinary parchment paper (15x2,8cm) and place it on the multi grid no 8. Emboss with embossing tool small ball and extra small ball stainless steel. Replace the parchment paper on the grid to get the whole pattern embossed.

CUTTING

With pointed scissors stainless steel (PG11321) the 1-needle perforations of the butterflies. When you do not like to cut, perforate the 1-needle perforations once more with perforating tool 2-split (PG11125). Then push the butterfly with your thumb out of the parchment paper.

FINISHING

Fold the card and attach the butterflies and the strip of ordinary parchment paper to the card with small dots of Perga Glue (PG41805)
